Sunday Morning's Sermon

Sermon: "The More EXCELLENT WAY!" (Part 6)

* This lesson continues a look at the characteristics of LOVE as revealed in 1 Cor. 13:4-8.

A. 1 Cor. 12:31 - **BACKGROUND** - What is the "More Excellent Way?"

1. The More Excellent Way [noted in 1 Cor. 12:31] is LOVE [as described in 1 Cor. 13].
* Gk. Wd. More Excellent = means "Superiority, excellence, Pre-eminence, Beyond Measure"
2. Is LOVE a "Feeling" or an "Action" a "Behavior?"
* "Love" is something that is done = a behavior / action. [Jn 3:16 - God loved by giving.]

B. (1 Cor. 13:4-8 = Love's Nature) - What are the True Characteristics of LOVE?

1. 1 Cor. 13:4 - So Far... we've looked at Eight (8) Characteristics of LOVE:
* Love is Patient; Kind; Not Envious [Not Jealous]; Not Boastful [Does Not Brag]; Not Arrogant [Not Proud]; Not Rude; Not Self-Seeking [Not Selfish]; Not Easily Angered [Not Short-tempered]
2. 1 Cor. 13:5 - Love K N R O W.
 - a) Thayer [Gk./Eng. Lexicon] - "to reckon, count, compute, calculate, count over; hence to make account of; to pass to one's account; to impute."
 - b) A.T. Robertson [Gk. Word Pictures] - "to count up; to take account of as in a ledger or notebook the evil done with a view toward S T A."
 - c) We Might Summarize it: "Love does Not H G!"
- d) Instead of "Holding Grudges" - Love F _____ !
- e) Bible says - We MUST be F _____ in order to be F _____ !

* APPLICATION - HOW can we Better Forgive and NOT Keep a Record of Wrongs [Not Hold Grudges]?
